SEXUAL HEALTH CENTRES – FAMILY PLANNING

GYNAECOLOGISTS

THIS SERVICE IS FOR ME FOR EXAMPLE IF

- → I am pregnant
- → I need a medical follow-up, advice and support concerning pregnancy or birth giving
- → I need guidance to find a place to give birth
- → I am looking for advice concerning any gynaecology issue

Gynaecologists specialise in women's health and deal with the sexual health, in the broad sense, of women of all ages. They provide answers to questions on sexuality, reproduction, and screening. They also provide the necessary care during pregnancy and the following months. Gynaecologists are entitled to prescribe their patients and their partners an appointment at the infertility service (UFN) of the Neuchâtel Hospital Network (RHNe) in cases where they have problems conceiving a child.

MATERNITY CARE DURING PREGNANCY AND BIRTH

MIDWIVES

THIS SERVICE IS FOR ME FOR EXAMPLE IF

- → I am pregnant
- → I need to prepare for the birth of my child
- \rightarrow I have given birth and wish to benefit from a follow-up for my baby and myself
- → I have questions related to breastfeeding
- → I need to talk to a healthcare practitioner

Midwives provide support, advice and care to women during their pregnancy, birth giving, and all the postpartum period. They are in charge of pregnancy consultations, the follow-up of at-risk pregnancies and birth preparation. Support to parents continues during the postpartum period to assist them concerning parenthood and provide advice on how the mother, father and siblings can adapt to the arrival of the new-born. They provide assistance in breastfeeding as well as medical and hygiene care. Courses are also proposed (massaging, baby carrying, etc.). Midwives assist birth giving in hospitals, at home or in birth centres.

RHNE – MATERNITY SERVICE

THIS SERVICE IS FOR ME FOR EXAMPLE IF

- → I am pregnant
- → I need advice and support regarding pregnancy and birth giving
- → I am looking for a place to give birth
- → I need to talk to a trusted professional about my infant

During pregnancy, the maternity care team provides pregnancy consultations, birth preparation sessions, and acupuncture and hypnosis consultations. An interview is organised with a midwife to establish a birth plan. In addition, adviser midwives provide support and advice in the case of a difficult family situation. Every woman is provided with an individualised follow-up, which includes alternative methods. And this follow-up continues after the baby's birth.

BIRTH CENTRE

THIS SERVICE IS FOR ME FOR EXAMPLE IF

- → I am pregnant
- → I need advice and support regarding pregnancy and birth giving
- → I need to talk to a trusted professional about my infant

Birth centres are an alternative to maternity services. This kind of setting allows for the establishment of a highly individualised physiological birth plan. The couple's follow-up is performed by the same midwives during the pregnancy, birth goving and after the child's birth. Services like birth preparation, haptonomy, acupuncture or yoga are proposed to future parents. Birth centres can only accept women who will not need a medical follow-up during birth giving.

RECIF aims to support and foster the integration of migrant women and their children as well as to encourage gatherings and exchanges between women from different backgrounds. RE-CIF provides a free care system for children between 4 months and 4 years old during courses, so that their mothers can take part in these courses. This is also an opportunity for the children to socialise and become familiar with the French language.

The Agency for Child Protection provides support to families who encounter education or social difficulties, under the form of a voluntary follow-up or a mandate. It is also the cantonal consultation centre for all questions regarding child abuse. It can orient parents towards appropriate education services depending on the specific situation of the family. It is possible to obtain information without having to open a case.

The AEMO is intended for parents and children aged between 0 and 18 who encounter education, relational and/or social difficulties and who need practical support on parenthood in daily actions. The AEMO helps parents to identify and understand the needs of their child to enhance his/her physical, mental, emotional and social development while reinforcing parents' education skills and maintaining the parent-child relation. It provides regular meetings at home, outside or at the AEMO for a fixed period.

NEUCHÂTEL RED CROSS, PSYCHO-EDUCATIONAL FOLLOW-UP

THIS SERVICE IS FOR ME FOR EXAMPLE IF

The psycho-educational follow-up provides support to children between 0 and 18 years old (and over) and their family. A two-person team composed of an educator and a psychologist visit families at their home, upon request from the parents or a professional. This service is provided to families who encounter integration, cultural adaptation, family, education, school, mental, social, communication, emotional, relational or violence issues. The psycho-educational follow-up staff works with all the members of the family to understand their difficulties and resources in order to find together remediation means and tools to enable them to regain an appropriate functioning and an agreeable family atmosphere.

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NEUCHÂTEL MENTAL HEALTH CENTRE (CNP)

The Neuchâtel mental health centre is the reference cantonal centre for all issues related to mental health. Anyone would naturally go to their doctor or paediatrician in the case of physical health problems. Likewise, it is as natural to obtain support to ensure one's mental wellbeing. Do not hesitate to ask for help if you need it.

The mental health service for children and teenagers of the CNP is more specifically intended for children between 0 and 18 years old and their family. It provides a large range of services for the care of children suffering from mental difficulties. Medical-psychological consultations are also proposed for children between 0 and 6 years old and their family, as well as for pregnant women encountering difficulties and their life partner. The CNP assesses and provides specific care to children, and offers support regarding parenthood.

The unit provides screening, assessments, as well as care for issues encountered by children and their parent(s): this may concern language, attention, attachment and behaviour disorders, or difficulties linked to parenthood. Care is adjusted according to the situation of each family.

PSYCHOLOGISTS, PSYCHOLOGISTS-PSYCHOTHERAPISTS

THIS SERVICE IS FOR ME FOR EXAMPLE IF

Psychologists and psychologists-psychotherapists offer care to persons who have psychological difficulties. They intervene to preserve, maintain or improve the quality of life or the wellbeing of patients, help them to develop their capacities or foster their social integration.

Therapy with a psychologist can be set up for many different reasons: mental disorders (phobias, depression, anxiety, etc.), complexes, romantic break-ups, burnout, and many others. Psychological assessments can also be provided, and a psychologist can propose psychological support for temporary difficulties.

Psychiatrists are doctors specialised in mental health, and child psychiatrists take care of children's mental health. How should you react if there are tensions? With the support of the Child health guidance teams, who monitor their development in its medical, mental, relational and social dimensions. These specialists are certified and can prescribe medicines if it is necessary.

Workshops are places where children can develop social relations, expression through their body and their creativity.
